




Implementation Steps for President Trump's proposal for a

"Comprehensive End of Gaza War"

Implementation steps:

1. President Trump announces the end to the war in the Gaza strip, and that the parties have agreed to implement the necessary steps to that end.
2. The war will immediately end upon the approval of the Israeli government. All military operations, including aerial and artillery bombardment and targeting operations will be suspended. During the 72 hour period, aerial surveillance will be suspended over the areas which IDF forces have withdrawn from.
3. Immediate commencement of full entry of humanitarian aid and relief as determined in the Proposal, and at a minimum in consistency with the 19 January 2025 agreement regarding humanitarian aid. Humanitarian aid and relief implementation steps are attached herewith.
4. IDF will withdraw to lines agreed upon as per map X attached herewith, and this will be completed after President Trump's announcement and within 24 hours of Israeli government approval. The IDF will not return to areas that have been withdrawn from, as long as Hamas fully implements the agreement.
5. Within 72 hours of the withdrawal of Israeli forces, all Israeli hostages, living and deceased, held in Gaza will be released (list attached).
  - a. As soon as IDF completes the withdrawal, Hamas will commence investigating the status of the hostages and collect all information pertaining to them. Hamas will provide feedback and on its findings through the information-sharing mechanism under 5.c below. Israel will provide information on the Palestinian prisoners and detainees from the Gaza strip held in Israel.
  - b. Within the 72 hours, Hamas will release all living hostages including those held by the Palestinian factions in Gaza.
  - c. Within the 72 hours, Hamas will release the remains of the deceased hostages in its possession and those in the possession of the Palestinian factions in Gaza.
  - d. Hamas will share, within the 72 hours, all the information it obtained relating to any remaining deceased hostages through the information-sharing mechanism in paragraph (c) below. Israel will provide information on the remains of the deceased Gazans held by Israel.
  - e. Establishment of an information-sharing mechanism between the two sides through the mediators and the ICRC, to exchange information and intelligence on any remaining deceased hostages that were not retrieved within the 72 hours or remains of Gazans held by Israel. The mechanism shall ensure that the remains of all the hostages are fully and safely exhumed and released. Hamas shall exert maximum effort to ensure the fulfillment of these commitments as soon as possible.
  - f. As Hamas release all the hostages, Israel will release in parallel the corresponding number of Palestinian prisoners as per the attached lists.
  - g. The exchange of hostages and prisoners will be done according to the mechanism agreed upon through the mediators and through the ICRC without any public ceremonies or media coverage.
6. A task force will be formed of representatives from the United States, Qatar, Egypt, Turkey and other countries to be agreed upon by the parties, to follow-up on the implementation with the two sides and coordinate with them.

c. Within the 72 hours, Hamas will release the remains of the deceased hostages in its possession and those in the possession of the Palestinian factions in Gaza.

d. Hamas will share, within the 72 hours, all the information it obtained relating to any remaining deceased hostages through the information-sharing mechanism in paragraph (e) below. Israel will provide information on the remains of the deceased Gazans held by Israel.

e. Establishment of an information-sharing mechanism between the two sides through the mediators and the ICRC, to exchange information and intelligence on any remaining deceased hostages that were not retrieved within the 72 hours or remains of Gazans held by Israel. The mechanism shall ensure that the remains of all the hostages are fully and safely exhumed and released. Hamas

shall exert maximum effort to ensure the fulfillment of these commitments as soon as possible.

f. As Hamas release all the hostages, Israel will release in parallel the corresponding number of Palestinian prisoners as per the attached lists.

g. The exchange of hostages and prisoners will be done according to the mechanism agreed upon through the mediators and through the Icrc without any public ceremonies or media coverage.

A task force will be formed of representatives from the United States, Qatar, Egypt, Turkey and other countries to be agreed upon by the parties, to follow-up on the implementation with the two sides and coordinate with them.

## Fasi di attuazione della proposta del presidente Trump sulla “Fine globale della guerra di Gaza”

Il presidente Trump annuncia la fine della guerra nella Striscia di Gaza, e le parti concordano di attuare i passi necessari a tale fine.

La guerra terminerà immediatamente con l’approvazione del governo israeliano. Tutte le operazioni militari, compresi i bombardamenti aerei e di artiglieria e le operazioni di targeting, saranno sospese. Durante il periodo di 72 ore, la sorveglianza aerea sarà sospesa sulle aree dalle quali le forze dell’Idf si saranno ritirate.

Avvio immediato dell’ingresso completo degli aiuti umanitari e dei soccorsi come stabilito nella Proposta, e almeno in coerenza con l’accordo del 19 gennaio 2025 riguardante gli aiuti umanitari. Le misure di implementazione degli aiuti umanitari e dei soccorsi sono allegate al presente documento.

L’Idf si ritirerà sulle linee concordate secondo la mappa allegata, e ciò sarà completato dopo l’annuncio del Presidente Trump e entro 24 ore dall’approvazione del governo israeliano. L’Idf non tornerà nelle aree dalle quali si sarà ritirato, fintanto che Hamas attuerà pienamente l’accordo.

Entro 72 ore dal ritiro delle forze israeliane, tutti gli ostaggi israeliani, vivi e deceduti, trattenuti a Gaza saranno rilasciati.

a. Non appena l’Idf completerà il ritiro, Hamas inizierà a verificare lo stato degli ostaggi e raccogliere tutte le informazioni relative a loro. Hamas fornirà riscontri e le proprie conclusioni attraverso il meccanismo di condivisione delle informazioni di cui al punto 5. e qui sotto. Israele fornirà informazioni sui prigionieri e detenuti palestinesi della Striscia di Gaza trattenuti in Israele.

b. Entro 72 ore, Hamas rilascerà tutti gli ostaggi vivi, compresi quelli detenuti dalle fazioni palestinesi a Gaza.

c. Entro 72 ore, Hamas rilascerà i corpi degli ostaggi deceduti in suo possesso e in possesso delle fazioni palestinesi a Gaza.

d. Hamas condividerà, entro 72 ore, tutte le informazioni ottenute riguardo gli eventuali corpi di ostaggi non ancora restituiti, attraverso il meccanismo di condivisione delle informazioni di cui al paragrafo (e) sotto. Israele fornirà informazioni sui corpi dei gazawi deceduti trattenuti in Israele.

e. Istituzione di un meccanismo di condivisione delle informazioni tra le due parti tramite i mediatori e il Cidr, per scambiarsi informazioni e dati di intelligence su eventuali corpi di ostaggi non restituiti entro le 72 ore o corpi di gazawi trattenuti da Israele. Il meccanismo garantirà che i resti di tutti gli ostaggi siano pienamente e in sicurezza riesumati e restituiti. Hamas farà il

massimo sforzo per garantire l'adempimento di questi impegni il più presto possibile.

f. Mentre Hamas rilascia tutti gli ostaggi, Israele rilascerà in parallelo un corrispondente numero di prigionieri palestinesi secondo le liste allegate.

g. Lo scambio di ostaggi e prigionieri sarà effettuato secondo il meccanismo concordato tramite i mediatori e il Cidr, senza alcuna cerimonia pubblica o copertura mediatica.

Sarà istituita una task force composta da rappresentanti di Stati Uniti, Qatar, Egitto, Turchia e altri Paesi da concordare tra le parti, per seguire l'attuazione con entrambe le parti e coordinarsi con esse.
